


## Randomizing Answer Choices

### Randomizing Answer Choices

PsychData allows you to randomize your answer choices in certain question types:

- Single Select Radio
- Multiselect/Check All
- Single Select Dropdown
- Multi-Select Dropdown
- Image Picker

If you want to randomize a question's answer choices, this option can be applied in the "Choices" panel in the sidebar beneath the words "Choices sort order."
